

**MINUTES OF THE MISSISSIPPI ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY  
PERMIT BOARD  
HELD IN JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI, ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2013**

The Mississippi Environmental Quality Permit Board held a meeting in the Commission Hearing Room of the Department of Environmental Quality, located at 515 East Amite Street, on November 12, 2013. Dennis Riecke called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with the following members and designated representatives present:

Leslie Royals was absent from the meeting and there was no designee from the Mississippi State Health Department present. Benny French was also absent.

Lisa Ouzts, Senior Attorney, was present as legal counsel. On motion by Jan Boyd and seconded by Michael Bograd, the minutes of the regular meeting on October 8, 2013, were approved.

**Surface Mining Bond Releases**

The Permit Board, on motion by David Snodgrass and seconded by Jan Boyd, voted to approve issuance of the bond releases listed above. (Mike Bograd abstained)

Kentucky-Tennessee Clay Company      Benton County      P98-046

Mr. Arnold Rooker, the land owner, objected to Kentucky-Tennessee Clay Company's, the operator's, request for a final 70% release of its reclamation bond. Mr. Rooker and representatives from Kentucky-Tennessee Clay Company ("Company") were present and were allowed to address the Permit Board. Mr. Rooker objected to the Company's request for final bond release because he was not satisfied with the Company's reclamation efforts. Mr. Rooker stated that his land was not returned to its original pre-mining condition. Mr. Daniel Hoskins also addressed the Board. Mr. Hoskins advised the Permit Board that he cuts hay on Mr. Rooker's land and that driving over the land is now too rough.

Representatives from the Company presented photographs to the Permit Board that had been taken between the Board's October 2013 and November 2013 meetings. The Company representatives advised the Board of the Company's efforts to reclaim the land and provided photographs and printed materials documenting those efforts. Mr. James Matheny, with MDEQ's Office of Geology, made several trips to the site with Mr. Rooker and Company representatives. Mr. Matheny advised the Board that the state regulations require slope stabilization and vegetation and that while there are some depressions on the site, the regulations do not require filling in of the depressions. Mr. Matheny also advised the Board of the Company's further efforts to address erosion.

Mr. Matheny advised the Permit Board that the site has been completely reclaimed and recommended that the Board release the remaining 70% of the bond.

On motion by Jan Boyd and seconded by David Snodgrass, the Board voted to accept the staff's recommendation. Mike Bograd abstained.

Lisa Ouzts advised Mr. Rooker of his right to request an evidentiary hearing within 30 days of the Permit Board's decision to approve the bond release.

**Surface Mining Permit to Rescind**

Eutaw Construction Company, Inc.                      Monroe County                      P12-025

Eutaw Construction Company requested that the Permit Board rescind its Surface Mining Permit, No. P12-025, because it had not mined the area and did not intend to mine the area. Eutaw Construction Company also requested return of its reclamation bond. MDEQ staff recommended approval of Eutaw's requests.

On motion by David Snodgrass and second by Jan Boyd, the Board accepted the staff's recommendation to rescind the permit and return the bond. Mike Bograd abstained.

**Surface Mining Permit to Transfer**

Jackson Ready-Mix Concrete                      Copiah County                      P90-002

Jackson Ready-Mix Concrete requested transfer of its permit, No. P90-002, to Krystal Gravel, Inc. Jackson Ready-Mix Concrete also requested return of its bond. The staff recommended approval of Jackson Ready-Mix's requests.

On motion by Jan Boyd and second by David Snodgrass, the Board accepted the staff's recommendations to transfer the permit and return the bond. Mike Bograd abstained.

**Surface Mining Application**

Memphis Stone & Gravel Company                      DeSoto County                      A1872

On August 12, 2013, the Mining and Reclamation Division of the Office of Geology received a surface mining application from Memphis Stone and Gravel. The applicant proposed to open pit mine 180 acres to a total depth of 55 feet for sand and gravel. Public notice was issued on August 22, 2013. On August 28, 2013, the Office of Geology received a letter from the Mississippi Department of Archives and History, stating no cultural resources would likely be affected by the proposed mining. The public notice period ended on September 9, 2013. Approximately three weeks after the public notice period ended, Ms. Johnnie Jacobs, NHPA Section 106 Coordinator of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, emailed MDEQ staff requesting copies of any correspondence the Office of Geology received from the State Historic Preservation Officer. Mr. James Matheny emailed a copy of the August 22, 2013, MDAH letter to Ms. Jacobs the day Ms. Jacobs made her request. Mr. Matheny informed Ms. Jacobs that because MDAH determined that no cultural resources would be affected by the proposed mine, a cultural resources survey would not be required.

Mr. Alan Parks, Vice President of Memphis Stone and Gravel, was present and spoke in favor of the permit.

On motion by David Snodgrass and seconded by Jan Boyd, the Board accepted the staff's recommendation to issue the permit. Mike Bograd abstained.

**City of Meridian – Meridian South POTW:**

**Modification of NPDES Permit**

**Lauderdale County**

**MS0020117**

Mr. Harry Wilson, Chief of MDEQ's Environmental Permitting Division, presented the Board with the City of Meridian's application for modification of its NPDES permit for the Meridian South Publically Owned Treatment Works. Mr. Wilson reminded the Board that it had previously denied Mr. Dan Check's request for a public hearing because there was not sufficient public interest for a public meeting. MDEQ's General Counsel, Mr. Roy Furrh, advised the Permit Board that he notified Mr. Check on October 10, 2013, that the Board denied his request for a public hearing and invited him to the November 12, 2013, Permit Board meeting. Mr. Check renewed his request for a public meeting via fax dated November 2, 2013, and Mr. Furrh responded through correspondence dated November 6, 2013. Mr. Furrh advised the Board that he reiterated that Mr. Check could attend the Board's November 12, 2013, meeting and ask the Board to reconsider his request for a public meeting.

Mr. Andrew Whitehurst with the Gulf Restoration Network was allowed to address the Board regarding the proposed permit modification. Mr. Whitehurst expressed concern with the complexity of the permits for Meridian's South and East plants and the future plans to pipe Meridian's treated wastewater to the Kemper IGCC plant. The Board reviewed two comment letters Mr. Whitehurst submitted to MDEQ on behalf of the Gulf Restoration Network's Mississippi members. After meeting with Mr. Wilson and Bradley Crain, MDEQ's project engineer for the Meridian South POTW, Mr. Whitehurst withdrew his request for a public hearing.

Mr. Dan Check also addressed the Permit Board. Mr. Check had previously submitted written materials describing his concerns with the Meridian South POTW and submitted additional written materials to the Board the morning of the meeting and stamped by MDEQ on November 12, 2013. Mr. Check renewed his request for a public hearing. Mr. Wilson advised the Board that Mr. Whitehurst and Mr. Check were the only ones who requested a public hearing and Mr. Whitehurst withdrew his request. Mr. Wilson stated that there was, however, a voice mail after the public comment period had ended requesting notification if there was a public hearing scheduled. Mr. Wally Hudnall, a Meridian citizen, was present at the meeting and briefly addressed the Permit Board with his concerns regarding raw sewage releases from the Meridian North POTW. Mr. Hudnall stated that he was in favor of a public hearing.

On motion by David Snodgrass and seconded by Mr. Gene Robertson, the Permit Board unanimously denied Mr. Check's renewed request for a public hearing.

Subsequently, Mr. Whitehurst and Mr. Check provided their comments and Mr. Crain and Mr. Wilson gave a presentation to the Board which included a description of the proposed modifications of the Meridian South POTW – NPDES Permit No. MS0020117. The presentation also included a description of the Meridian East POTW permit and a description of the plans to pipe treated effluent from Meridian's POTW's to the Kemper County IGCC facility. Mr. Wilson advised the Permit Board that MDEQ staff recommended issuance of the modification to the NPDES permit for the Meridian South POTW.

On motion by Mr. Mike Bograd and seconded by Mr. Jan Boyd, the Permit Board voted unanimously to accept the staff's recommendation to issue the modification of NPDES Permit No. MS0020117.

## REPORT OF STAFF PERMIT ACTIONS/CERTIFICATIONS

Staff reported to the Permit Board that staff had taken action on various permits since the October 8, 2013, Permit Board Meeting pursuant to the regulations delegating this authority to the Executive Director and the Executive Director's delegation of this authority to the staff in accord with those regulations. The Permit Board voted to note and record in its minutes the reports of permit actions/certifications by staff since the October 8, 2013, Permit Board Meeting. [Jim Hoffmann abstained from voting on all Land and Water Resources permits and Mike Bograd abstained on all of the Office of Geology permits.]
