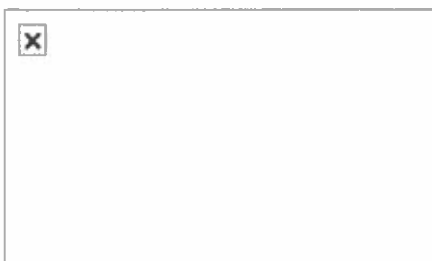

Michael – Sorry I have been delayed in getting back with you, but wanted to respond to your questions about the North Port project.

1. We will be submitting the plans to the City of Gulfport for review and permitting (grading/drainage permit). We plan on doing this in the next several weeks.
2. The project is presently being evaluated by FEMA, since it is anticipated that construction funds will come from FEMA as this project is a hurricane mitigation project (site to move trailers and equipment from port to in preparation of a storm). Part of this process is having an Environmental Assessment (EA) performed. It is anticipated that there will be a thirty (30) day public comment period once the EA is completed and reviewed by MSPA. Additionally, when the property was purchased by the Port, there were public meetings with the adjacent property owners (Turkey Creek Watershed Owners) to discuss MSPA's plans.
